VMB1- 1962-1999 - Cars 2000-3000cc (PRO3)

VMB2 - 1962-1999 - Cars 3000cc - 5000cc

**VLB** - 1962-1999 - Cars over 5000cc

**WT** - WINGS N THINGS – FA, FB, FC, FE, FL, FSV, F1, F2, etc.

**FF** - Formula Ford, Club Ford, - HFF, CF, VFF, MFF, Formula F, etc.

**SR** - Sports Racer – ASR, CSR, DSR, S2000, etc.

**SC1** - Similar to: CT4, EIP, T4, GTL, EP and other similar classes (Fastest Class in Group)

**SC2** - Similar to: ITA, ITS, FP, SM, SMT, STL and other similar classes (Medium Class in Group)

**SC3** - Similar to: CSM, BSPEC, CR, HP and other similar classes (Slowest Class in Group)

**LB1** - Similar to: GT1, T1, LMS. SST, SPO and other similar classes (Fastest Class in Group)

**LB2** - Similar to: GT2, GT3, SPO, SPM, T2 and Similar other classes (Medium Class in Group)

**LB3** - Similar to: SE46, T3, ITE, ST, SPU, AS and Similar other classes (Slowest Class in Group)

These "similar to" classes are examples of classes which clubs may run. There are many other types of club classes that will fit with in our combined class structure. We will find a place where you will fit your car preparation.
